"It's in the blood, so the styles could resemble... we even sign the same, hence the reason why I actually put an A. Mijares... my father, my uncles, we all sign with Caps."

Q:What inspires you, Alex?

"I come home and I have no idea what I want to paint, I travel and I take a bunch of photos so I always have all of this stuff in my head... I wake up with something in my head and I'm like alright I gotta paint that."

Alex goes on to explain his artistic process... " I don't sketch anything, usually everything I do, is I start with paint so I can't erase... I start off painting one thing and by the time I get to the other side of the canvas, a whole story has been developed."

Q: Does your heritage play a role in your art?

"I would say very much so. My mom is Cuban and my dad's from Spain, so it has that very Latin, tons of water, mountains, dancing, music and bright colors..."

Q: Which artists have influenced you?

"Cundo Bermúdez, Picasso... The Greats! What I like about their style is they always painted and created something from nothing... creating facial expressions, body expressions that don't exist, that you can't find in a magazine or a book."

And last, but certainly not least, I wondered who the woman is that infatuates much of Mijares' work, as he let out a boyish grin, he responded... *"There's a few, that basically pertain to certain people, sometimes not, sometimes maybe it's what I'm looking for..."*
